

# Mapping Global Citizenship in Peterborough & the Kawarthas

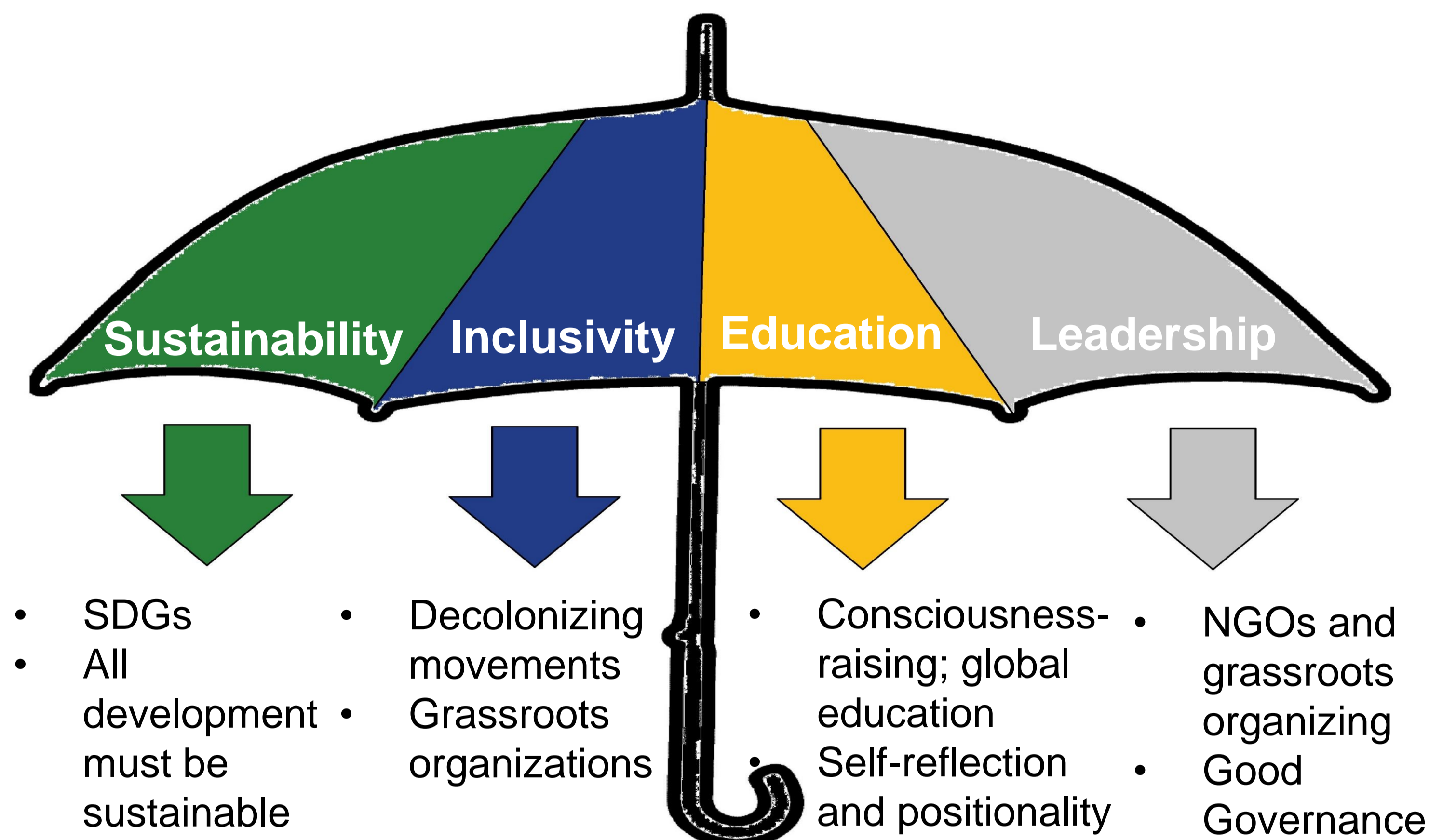
## Purpose

The purpose of the project is to:

- Understand guiding values
- Bring awareness and action on the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDG).

This scan will allow us to recognize, quantify, and celebrate the breadth of global citizenship and global connection work in the area.

## Best Practices of Development



- Approximately 100 groups, organizations, school clubs, and individuals doing global education and international development work in the community
- Wide range of focus on varying issues throughout the community
- Most funding supports local initiatives (such as global education)

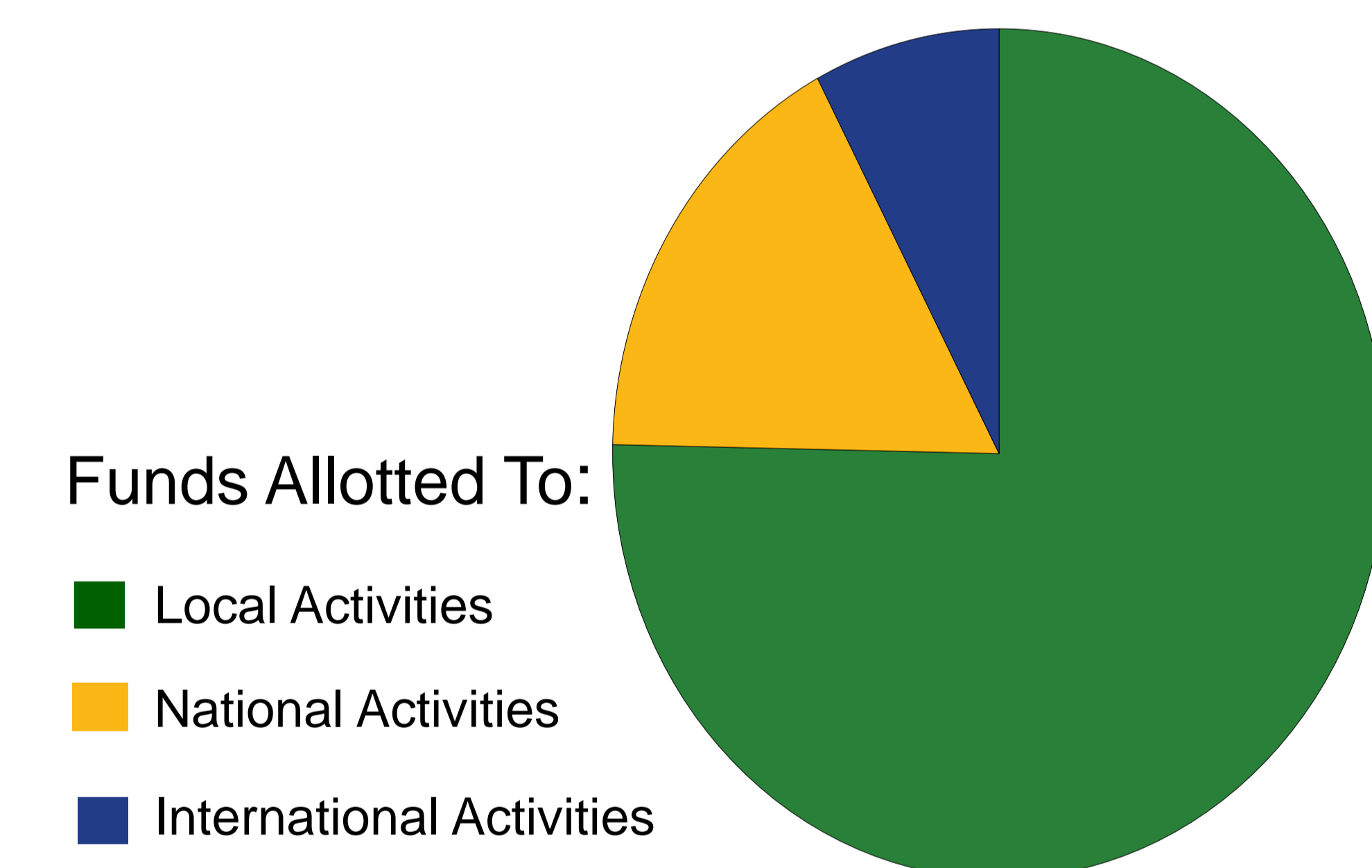
## Research Questions

## Findings

- Research concluded that best practice methods of development must be inclusive and sustainable in their approach to education and leadership
- Structural change which integrates all forms of knowledge and fosters global citizenship

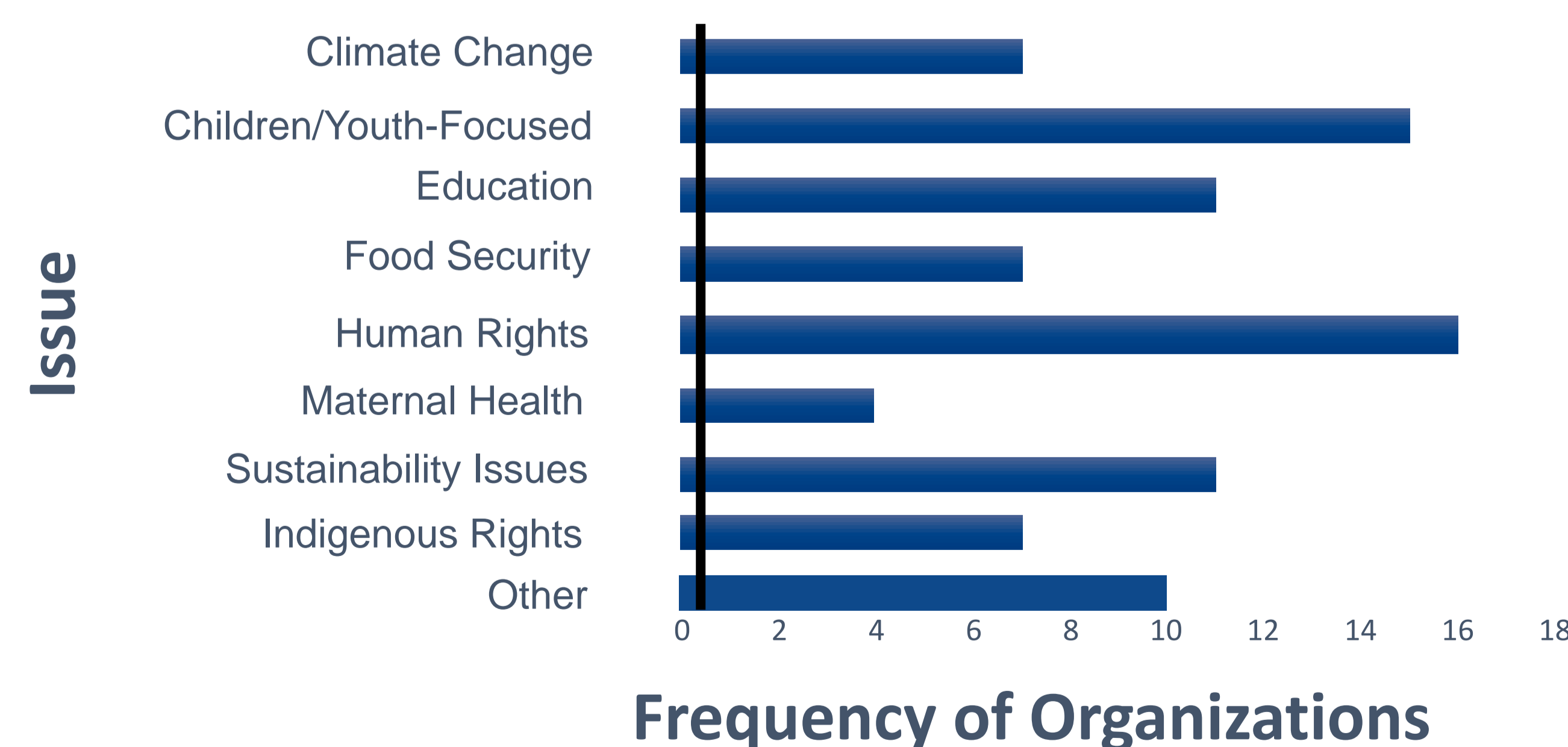
## Annual Budget of Organizations
