

Who are the Organizations?




Who is engaged in social justice initiatives directly related to poverty eradication in Peterborough City and County?





Observations:

- Breakfast only provided in shelters and school programs
- Dinner mainly offered during winter months only
- Most meals most easily accessible in shelters
- Access to food (i.e. fresh & non-perishables) is limited; once a month or on emergency basis
- Plenty of access to assistance with budgeting and accessing affordable living
- Access to affordable housing
- Shelters are mainly co-ed
- Limited storage for clothing and therefore little access
- Minimal access to showers
- Minimal access to laundry facilities
- Less than 50% participation in the survey
